Sew What

Our next *Sew What* event is scheduled for next **Sunday, March 8th at 2:00 PM** in the *Fellowship Hall*. We will continue our mission to support *Pillows of Love* by stitching unique pillowcases, which will be distributed to women and children (and occasionally men) who are in distressing situations. Complete with a Psalm on the cuff and a New Testament Bible inside, they offer support when it is most needed. We will also add, stitching a sample bib that we will donate to the *Lebanon Family Health Services*.

Your help is needed. Tasks include tracing a pattern, cutting the fabric, pinning, machine sewing, ironing, and attaching snaps or Velcro. If you have a portable sewing machine, please bring it along!

Do you have any fabric that you aren't using? There is a need for it at *Sew What*. Fabric that is about 12" x 10" or larger with fun patterns could be used as a gift for a newborn. Fabric at least 41" wide would be suitable for a pillowcase. Lengths of 26", 10", and 2" are also needed for a pillowcase.
